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
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
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Dear Friends & Collaborators

As we reflect on the past quarter, we also celebrate a meaningful milestone—five years of Sampoorna Shiksha. What began as a small step rooted in the belief that learning should be joyful and inclusive has grown into a collective movement powered by communities, partners, and volunteers across India. This quarter stands as a testament to that shared journey and the impact we continue to build together.

The past quarter was a vibrant celebration of joyful learning, community action, and collective impact. **Between October and December, together we reached 5,000+ children and 200+ teachers across India through learning, play, and skill-building initiatives.**

Quarter Highlights (Oct–Dec):

- 1. 34 Toy & Book Libraries** set up across states including West Bengal, Bihar, Maharashtra, Delhi, and Tamil Nadu, creating playful learning spaces for **5,000+ students**
- 2. A new Computer Lab** established under Project Tech Pathshala, benefiting **100+ students** and **10+ teachers**
- 3. Spoken English** sessions delivered across schools and community centres, reaching **900+ students** and **55+ teachers**, supported by volunteers in India and Dubai
- 4. STEM, Maths & Science** interventions benefiting **80+ students** through regular academic support
- 5. Kahani Utsav & Kala Utsav** storytelling and creative sessions impacting **400+ children** across **multiple states in India.**
- 6. Daan Utsav & donation drives** distributing clothes, bags, toys, stationery, ration kits, and 150 notebooks, impacting **650+ children** Across India.
- 7. Festive celebrations** including Diwali, Children's Day, Christmas, New Year, Guru Nanak Jayanti and World Science Day across partner schools and Community Centres Impacted **500+ Beneficiaries**

Each initiative strengthened our shared mission of making education joyful, inclusive, and empowering. None of this would be possible without our volunteers, partners, donors, and collaborators—your belief continues to turn classrooms into spaces of curiosity, confidence, and possibility.

Sampoorna Shiksha collaborated with **Tata Consultancy Services** employees through **TCS HOPE (Hours of Purpose)** to turn simple donation drives into meaningful acts of collective care.
