The year 2021–22 marked a period of resilience, innovation, and growth for Sampoorna Shiksha (Gyaandaan Foundation). Even as the world adjusted to the ongoing effects of the pandemic, our commitment to providing quality education and skill development only grew stronger.

We achieved significant milestones through:

The launch of digital classrooms and community libraries in remote regions of Bihar and Delhi, ensuring students had access to technology-enabled learning.

Expansion into new states including Maharashtra, Karnataka, and Uttarakhand, bringing holistic education to rural and tribal children.

Strengthening of global partnerships, such as our collaborations with India Club Dubai and Cambridge School Dubai, which empowered children through school-to-school adoption programs in spoken English.

Introduction of skill development programs like Tally ACE Certification, financial literacy workshops, and career counselling sessions that helped hundreds of youth prepare for employment opportunities.

Community empowerment projects such as Project Laadli (menstrual health awareness), festival-based celebrations, and livelihood initiatives for tribals and differently-abled artisans.

Our initiatives this year **touched over 3,560 beneficiaries, engaged more than 1,800 volunteers, and spanned 7,000+ hours of learning.** We successfully blended academic learning with cultural enrichment, soft skills, and vocational training, ensuring education was not just about classrooms, but about building confidence and dignity.

As we reflect on this journey, we are deeply grateful for the support of our donors, partners, and volunteers. It is their trust and commitment that has enabled us to create impact across geographies, cultures, and communities.

Sampoorna Shiksha, registered as Gyaandaan Foundation is a Mumbai-based, education-focused, Section 8 company founded in 2020 by Pushpa Subramanian and Lata Srinivasan, affectionately known as the Twin Educators. We work to make quality education and skill development accessible to children from underprivileged communities across India through innovative, low-cost, and scalable models. Guided by our vision to spread the light of education among the underprivileged children of our society, we design joyful, inclusive, and future-ready learning environments.

A. Shikshalaya: Building Learning Ecosystems

- **Project Kitab Khlona:** Toy & Book Libraries filled with curated educational toys, story cards, flashcards, puzzles, brain gym and finger gym tools, agility kits, art kits, and musical instruments.
- **Project Tech Pathshala:** Fully equipped computer labs that introduce students to digital literacy, online research, and typing/navigation skills.
- **Project E-Shiksha / E-Smart Kit:** Digital classroom kits with offline, board-aligned content, videos, and skill-based modules in multiple languages.

- **SS-Academy:** NEP-aligned teacher training focused on experiential learning, classroom management, and integrating stories, movement, and arts into teaching.
- **Skill Development Programs:** Workshops in life skills, storytelling, leadership, career readiness, digital & financial literacy.
- **English-on-Call:** Spoken English modules delivered in contextual, accessible formats to school and college learners.
- **Model School Program:** Comprehensive partnerships with schools and community centers to build sustainable, replicable education models.

SHIKSHALAYA 2021–22: BUILDING LEARNING ECOSYSTEMS



Project Kitab Khilona – Toy & Book Libraries

Education goes beyond textbooks — it is about play, imagination, and curiosity. In 2021–22, **we created community libraries in villages such as Jamui, Bansa, and Saharsa (Bihar)**. These were not just rooms with shelves, but vibrant centres filled with toys, puzzles, flashcards, agility kits, story cards, and art resources.

Project Tech Pathshala – Computer Labs

At Doon Public School (Saharsa, Bihar), we built a fully equipped computer laboratory alongside a digital classroom. The lab was furnished with state-of-the-art computers, internet access, and educational software. Students who had never touched a keyboard learned typing, navigation, and online research.

Project E-Shiksha / E-Smart Kit – Digital Classrooms

- **Doon Public School, Bihar:** With a 59-inch smart TV, webcam, CPU, and speakers, students of Grade X were mentored online by expert teachers. Their results spoke volumes — with more than 80% scores, they secured admission in better colleges. This project has now expanded to teaching grammar and other subjects for lower classes.
- **Pragati Wheel School, Delhi:** Children from farmer communities along the Yamuna banks were guided in “smart study methodologies” by Sampoorna Shiksha teachers. They successfully cleared NIOS Grade X exams with 70%+ scores.



SS Academy – Teacher Training

We believe that teachers are the bedrock of change. In 2021–22, we launched the SS Academy, training teachers to use the Quad Seek Method, a four-gradient model for pre-primary education.

Teachers conducted Fun Learning Sessions where one theme integrated multiple subjects — geography, science, history, values, and art. Children aged 5–15 learned through stories, activities, and festival-based sessions, gaining both knowledge and cultural awareness.

Skill Development Programs

- **Tally ACE Certification:** Youth from economically weaker sections were trained to earn employable skills, immediately opening access to jobs.
- **Career Counselling:** At Sahu Maharaj Vidyalaya, 400+ students received guidance in Hindi and Marathi on career options, vocational courses, and pathways to higher education.
- **Financial Literacy:** ITM B-school students taught industry-specific skills like budgeting and money management to underprivileged learners.
- **Livelihood Skills:**
 - Differently-abled artisans crafted diyas that were sold in homes and companies, giving them income and sustainability.
 - Tribal artists painted Warli art on bags, which were distributed as gifts to donors, providing dignified earnings.



Skill Development Programs

- **Summer Sensations Camp:** A week-long online camp engaged 200+ children from 10 centres. Activities included storytelling, puppet-making, dance, yoga, and STEM learning — two hours a day of creativity and exploration.
- **Katha & Crafts Festival:** Storyteller Seema Waghi led sessions in motivational, comedy, and value-based stories. Children enjoyed puppet-making, Warli painting, and drawing workshops. 100+ children from 10 centres participated.
- **Happy Pariksha Project:** 200+ exam kits with transparent pouches, writing pads, pens, and geometry boxes were distributed to SSC students in Maharashtra.
- **Uniform Donation Drive:** Apeejay School Nerul donated gently used uniforms, benefitting 300+ tribal children in Raigad, Thane, and Palghar.
- **Joyful Gifting:** With Joyful Gifting's support, we distributed 700+ Best of Luck kits containing pencils, rulers, sharpeners, and erasers across 8+ schools.
- **Festivals & Celebrations:**
 1. **Navratri & Dussehra** — Kanya Pooja and Anna Daan for 200+ girls and 300+ community members across 15+ centres.
 2. **Diwali at Jambulpada (Thane)** — distribution of books, diyas, pencils, and community meals prepared by villagers. Games and dances added to the joy.
 3. **Project Laadli:** Menstrual health awareness campaigns conducted in rural and tribal regions using visual aids and kits. Volunteers were trained to sustain these conversations locally.

- **India Club Dubai** students taught spoken English to children of **Borderless World Foundation, Jammu.**
- **Cambridge School Dubai** partnered for the second consecutive year, adopting schools and showcasing the program at **Expo 2020 Dubai.**
- **Apeejay School Nerul** adopted **Sainath School Vashi**, mentoring students in English and helping them speak with confidence.

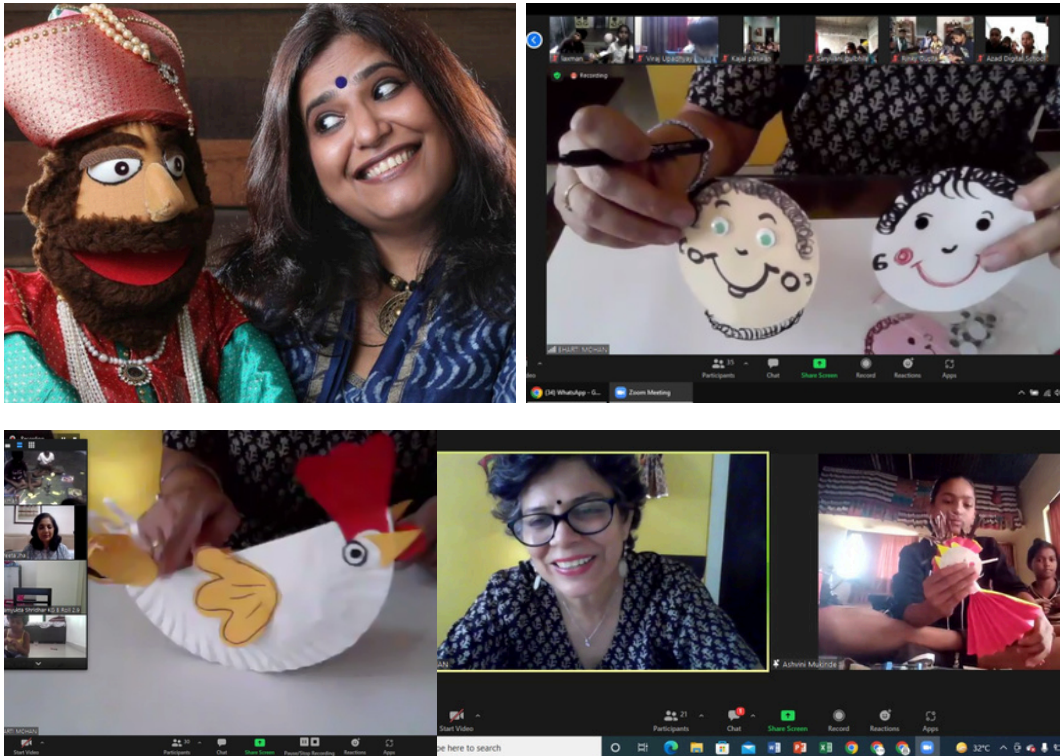

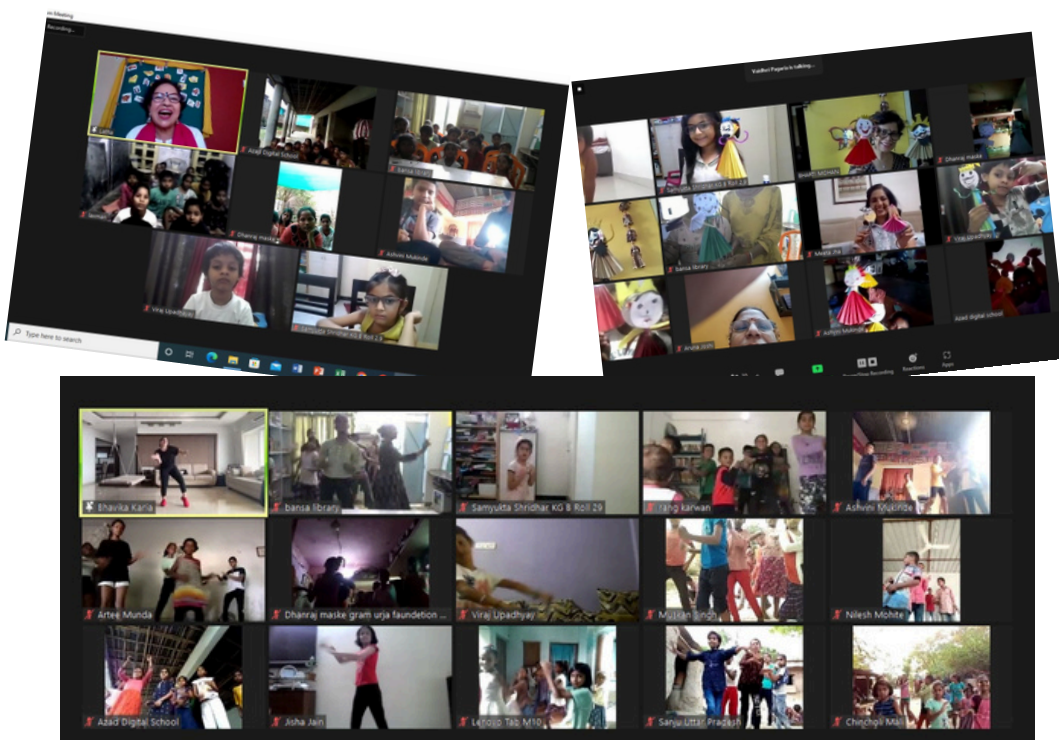

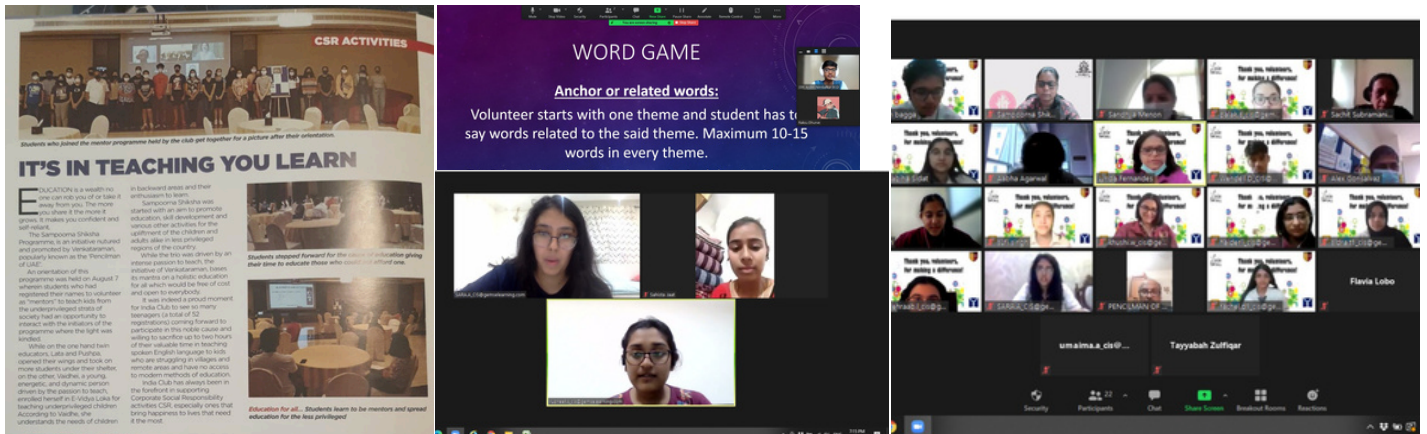
