The year 2022–23 was a journey of vibrant learning, celebration, and community building for Sampoorna Shiksha (Gyaandaan Foundation). From classrooms in Saharsa, Bihar, to community centres in Navi Mumbai, our efforts carried the promise of education to children and youth across India.

We achieved significant milestones through:

Digital Classrooms — Inaugurating our first digital classroom at Doon Public School, Saharsa, Bihar, ensuring rural students could access high-quality online coaching and teacher training support.

Student Success Stories — Celebrating the achievements of children like Dayal, once a runaway child now passing Class X, and the outstanding CBSE results of students from Doon School guided by volunteer-mentors.

Skill Development & Summer Engagements — Organising summer camps with storytelling, robotics, dance, and music for 100+ children, alongside continuous spoken English sessions in Tamil Nadu, Gujarat, and other centres.

Teacher Training — Launching our teacher training courses at Pt. Motilal Nehru High School, Nerul and Biru Learning Centre, empowering educators with new tools, lesson plans, and pedagogical practices.

Toy & School Supplies Libraries — Setting up toy libraries in Rishikesh, Dalwalla, Uttarkashi, and other centres, giving hundreds of children access to joyful, play-based learning resources.

Career Counselling & Employability — Conducting sessions with students at Seva Sahayog Foundation, Sahu Maharaj Schools, and others, guiding them towards sustainable pathways.

Internships & Youth Engagement — Partnering with ITM, NMIMS, Somaiya, and other institutions, where 100+ student interns contributed through teaching, fundraising, digital media, and content design.

Community Celebrations — Marking national festivals, from Republic Day and Independence Day to Pongal, Diwali, and Holi, bringing colour, belonging, and cultural pride into children's learning spaces.

Recognition & Partnerships — Being chosen as a Top 10 Finalist by Pure India Trust, representing at the Civil-20 of the G20, and strengthening collaborations with Echope Foundation, Joyful Gifting, and others.

Our programs this year touched 3,500+ children and youth, engaged 1,500+ volunteers and interns, and expanded our reach across Bihar, Uttarakhand, Maharashtra, Karnataka, Tamil Nadu, and Delhi.

This year's work reminds us that education is not only about textbooks and exams—it is about confidence, creativity, and community. We are deeply grateful to all our donors, volunteers, and partners for walking with us in this journey.

Guided by our vision to spread the light of education among the underprivileged children of our society, we design joyful, inclusive, and future-ready learning environments.

- **Project Kitab Khlona:** Toy & Book Libraries filled with curated educational toys, story cards, flashcards, puzzles, brain gym and finger gym tools, agility kits, art kits, and musical instruments.
- **Project Tech Pathshala:** Fully equipped computer labs that introduce students to digital literacy, online research, and typing/navigation skills.
- **Project E-Shiksha / E-Smart Kit:** Digital classroom kits with offline, board-aligned content, videos, and skill-based modules in multiple languages.

SHIKSHALAYA 2021–22: BUILDING LEARNING ECOSYSTEMS



Project Kitab Khilona – Toy & Book Libraries

Education is not only taught — it is played, narrated, and discovered. In 2022–23, Sampoorna Shiksha expanded Toy & Story Libraries across rural and tribal schools, turning classrooms into playgrounds of imagination.

In **Swami Shivananda School, Rishikesh**, over **300 students** explored math, science, and English through hands-on educational kits, making abstract concepts tangible.

At **Dalwalla School, Rishikesh**, nearly **100 children** opened their very first toy library, where puzzles, games, and science toys nurtured curiosity and problem-solving.

In **Kamand Hanumad Shikshan Sanstha, Uttarkashi**, **120 children** gained access to toys and story resources that sparked both learning and joy, while community gatherings brought traditional music and dance alongside modern play.

In **Karjat, Maharashtra**, in partnership with **Think Sharp Foundation**, toy libraries were inaugurated across three **Zilla Parishad schools**, reaching **200+ children**. The excitement was palpable as teachers and students explored flashcards, puzzles, and folk games together.

Workshops like the **Pan-India Storytelling Summer Workshop (200 children across 6+ centres)** gave children space to imagine their friends in trees, rivers, and rocks — learning science and empathy through narrative.

Together, Project Kitab Khilona reached over 700+ children this year, ensuring that learning was not only about lessons, but about play, creativity, and wonder.

Project E-Shiksha / E-Smart Kit – Digital Classrooms

Technology became a bridge where teachers were missing. In 2022–23, Sampoorna Shiksha established digital classrooms and computer labs to bring world-class learning to rural schools.

At **Doon School, Saharsa, Bihar**, a digital classroom was launched to coach Class X students for CBSE exams. **Over 100 students** benefited from online teaching, while volunteer mentors stepped in to bridge subject gaps.

Later, with the support of **Echope Foundation**, a computer lab of five systems was set up at the same school, **giving 250 students** their first structured access to technology.

At **Majalgaon School, Maharashtra**, an E-Learning Centre was opened, connecting rural children to new possibilities in science and mathematics.

In **Pt Motilal School, Nerul**, an interactive digital classroom was inaugurated with an e-learning display panel and teacher training for **250 children and 13 teachers**.

These spaces were not just about screens — they were about dreams. From watching the Chandrayaan-3 Landing live to learning spoken English through interactive modules, children experienced technology as empowerment.

Project E-Shiksha / E-Smart Kit – Digital Classrooms

Project E-Shiksha deepened its footprint this year, ensuring digital kits and tools could reach semi-urban and rural learners.

In **Swami Shivananda School, Rishikesh**, the **E-Shiksha Kit** benefitted **300+ students from Classes 8–12**, blending semi-English curriculum with interactive learning. Teachers were trained to use the kit effectively, making it a sustainable classroom transformation.

Toy & digital learning libraries were also launched in Dalwalla School and Kamand School, Uttarkashi, bringing science, math, and language toys to 300+ children.

At **Rabale's Child of the World Centre**, **E-Shiksha** expanded to strengthen foundational learning, ensuring children from low-income communities had equal exposure to digital aids.

In total, **500+ children and 20+ teachers were empowered through Project E-Shiksha** this year, bridging gaps in access and pedagogy with technology-driven learning.

SS Academy

Teachers are the backbone of any classroom. Through SS Academy, we equipped educators with new methods, resources, and confidence.

- At **Pandit Motilal School, Nerul, 6 teachers** trained in visual teaching methods — lesson plans, flashcards, and interactive activities that made learning joyful for 50+ children.
- At **Biru Learning Centre (Jharkhand)**, a foundational learning program was launched, empowering local teachers to use structured teaching aids.

English on Call

Breaking the barriers of geography and access, English-on-Call connected children from rural and underserved schools with volunteer mentors across India and abroad. Through phone-based, group, and one-on-one sessions, children gained fluency and confidence in spoken English.

- **Pandit Motilal School, Nerul – 80+ students** benefitted from group spoken English classes facilitated by interns.
- **Tirunelveli District, Tamil Nadu – 45 rural children** participated in regular spoken English sessions.
- **Pardhi communities, Maharashtra** – dedicated sessions built foundational skills for marginalized children.
- **Doon School, Saharsa** – mentorship helped 10+ students succeed in CBSE Class X.
- **Signature Foundation Teachers – 6 educators** completed spoken English training, improving both their teaching and self-confidence.



Skill Development Programs

Learning extended far beyond textbooks into dance, music, languages, and storytelling.

- **Kathak classes at Gaura Learning Centre, Bihar**, brought classical dance to 10 children.
- **Bhajan sessions with Chinmaya Naad Bindu at Amar Jyoti School (30+)**, later carried online to Uttarkashi, kept children connected through rhythm and reflection.
- **Career counselling at Seva Sahayog Foundation, Pune**, guided 90+ students towards future opportunities.
- Storytelling sessions touched children in SSST Gujarat (30+), Pardhi communities, and beyond — opening minds through narrative imagination.
- **Student Leadership Program at Aasraa Trust, Dehradun**, culminated with 15 students showcasing their growth as leaders through skits and talks.
- **12 interns from ITM Kharghar** conducted Spoken English sessions, fundraising, and social media campaigns.
- **Stree Mukti Sanghatana** celebrations co-hosted by ITM interns gave children memorable experiences.
- Volunteers like Vidita Ganesh (student mentor), Geetika Sharma (dance facilitator), and many others brought talent, time, and heart.
- **Rangoli workshops with Sacred Light Foundation (15+ children)**.
- Teacher's Day and Annual Day Celebrations, honouring educators and volunteers for making dreams real.
- Diwali outreach across Uttarakhand schools and community centres, bringing gifts, lunch, and performances to 100+ children.
- Christmas celebrations with Stree Mukti Sanghatana, Panvel, and Khandeshwar, reaching 80+ children with joy, gifts, and play.



RECOGNITION & MILESTONES

- Dayal's story of resilience, from a runaway child to clearing Class X with the Lighthouse Cohort, became a symbol of what collective mentorship can achieve.
- Doon School, Saharsa students cleared Class X CBSE with 70%+, supported by online mentorship.
- Annual Day 2022 marked two years of Sampoorna Shiksha, celebrating donors, teachers, and children with gratitude and resolve.
- Pure India Trust: Top 10 finalist in the Pure Social Impact Awards (March 2023).
- C20 Civil Society (G20): Invited to present alongside 100 NGOs (May 2023).
- Goldcrest International: Our founder invited as Guest of Honour at the graduation ceremony (May 2023).

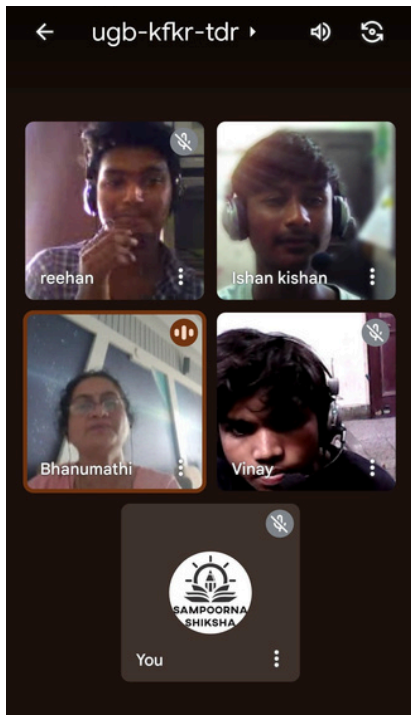
