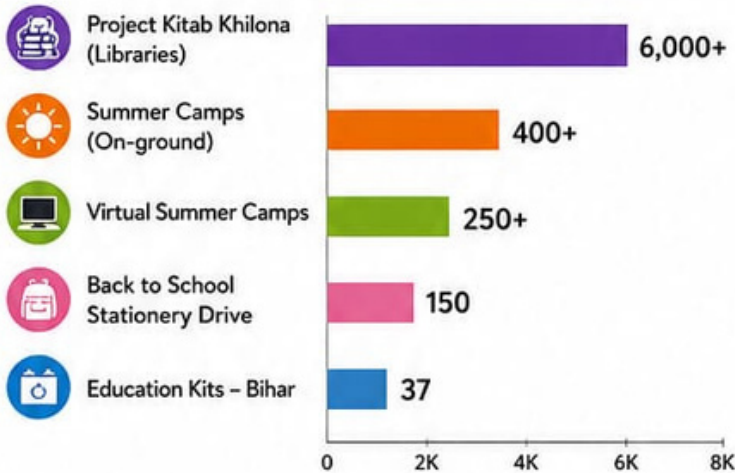

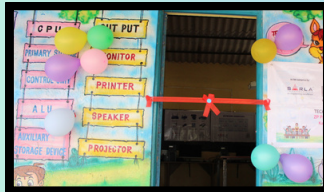

BOOKS, TOYS & JOY : PROJET KITAB KHILONA

21 Toy & Book Libraries set up across **8 states** impacting **6,000+ students** and **150+ teachers**, creating everyday access to play-based and literacy-rich learning.



PROJECT TECH PATHSHALA & E-SHIKSHA KITS

Through Project Tech Pathshala & E-Shiksha, we established **2 fully equipped computer lab** and **5 smartboards with content across 2 states** - enabling access to tech-driven, engaging learning environments for children.



PROJECT RANGSHAALA: LEARNING THROUGH COLOURS

Through Project Rangshaala, **two schools** in **Uran** and **Ulwe**, Navi Mumbai, were transformed with educational murals across **classrooms and school walls**. Featuring themes of **Education, Jungle Life, Science, and Technology**, the initiative turned the entire school into an engaging and interactive learning space, benefiting over **800 students**.



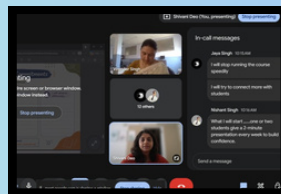
BACK TO SCHOOL: ESSENTIALS FOR SUCCESS

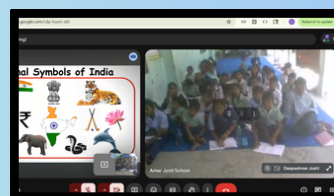
SUMMER CAMPS : FROM IDEAS TO APPLAUSE

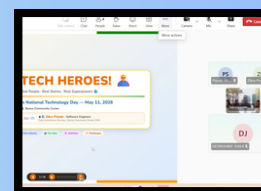
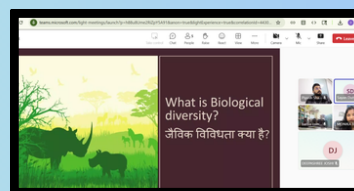
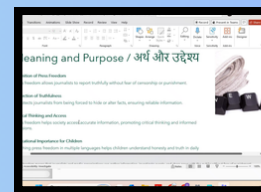
GIVING THAT MET REAL NEEDS
